## 12. Residence Choices

The Rate column reflects the monthly rate for each student and residence option, which includes basic utilities - water, heat, electricity, garbage and sewer. Additional fees apply for early arrival, late departure, house dues, and the technology fee.

Some residence choices offer "one quarter only" or "academic year only" contract lengths. Students who are assigned to those buildings are required to move at the end of these terms and cannot renew into those locations for the subsequent year. If you prefer to stay in the same apartment throughout this academic year and 2022-23 (based on eligibility), you should select residence choices that are open all year. Students who are assigned to one quarter only or autumn only locations/contracts will receive priority for assignment in the assignment rounds for winter and/or spring.

**IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING:** Stanford has secured off-campus leases at a number of apartment complexes in Menlo Park, Mountain View, Palo Alto, and Redwood City to help meet the demand for housing. These subsidized off-campus apartments will be offered along with the on-campus options. These units are furnished and include utilities. While off campus housing choices will be available to rank on the 2021-22 Lottery application, assignment to these spaces will be based on overall applicant demand and COVID-19 related requirements. Students listing these choices should also rank on-campus housing options. Given the uncertainties of the COVID-19 situation, students assigned to off-campus, subsidized housing should know that they may have to relocate to campus during the academic year due to emerging circumstances. If students are assigned off-campus for 2021-22, they are not able to renew for 2022-23 and may not sublicense their assignment.

## Gender Identity
